This is a full-time position of approximately 35-40 hours per week from late March until mid-October. Must be available to work early mornings (start time as early as 5:30am), weekends and some statutory holidays.

Under the general direction of the Superintendent and/or Supervisor, the successful candidate will be able to provide the following:

Responsibilities:

- Maintain greens, tees, fairways, rough and adjacent areas of the course
- Operate and care for course maintenance equipment.
- Safely operate all assigned equipment used for various course maintenance needs
- Participate in course cultural practices i.e. aeration, topdressing and verti-cutting
- Apply required fertilizer as directed by Management
- Perform course setup duties including pin placements, tee blocks, course presentation
- Clean and inspect equipment before and after use
- Report machinery/equipment problems to supervisor, or Equipment Technician
- Maintain bunkers and repairs divots
- Trim Trees/bushes, pull weeds, rake leaves and remove cuttings
- Present themselves in a professional manner
- Will from time to time assist in special projects as requested by Management

- Previous related experience in golf course or landscape maintenance an asset
- The ability to work alone, follow oral and written directions
- A good knowledge about tools, equipment and materials used in golf course maintenance
- Effective communication
